Do you like the smell?



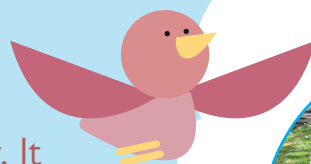
This Herb is called Rosemary and is often used for cooking.

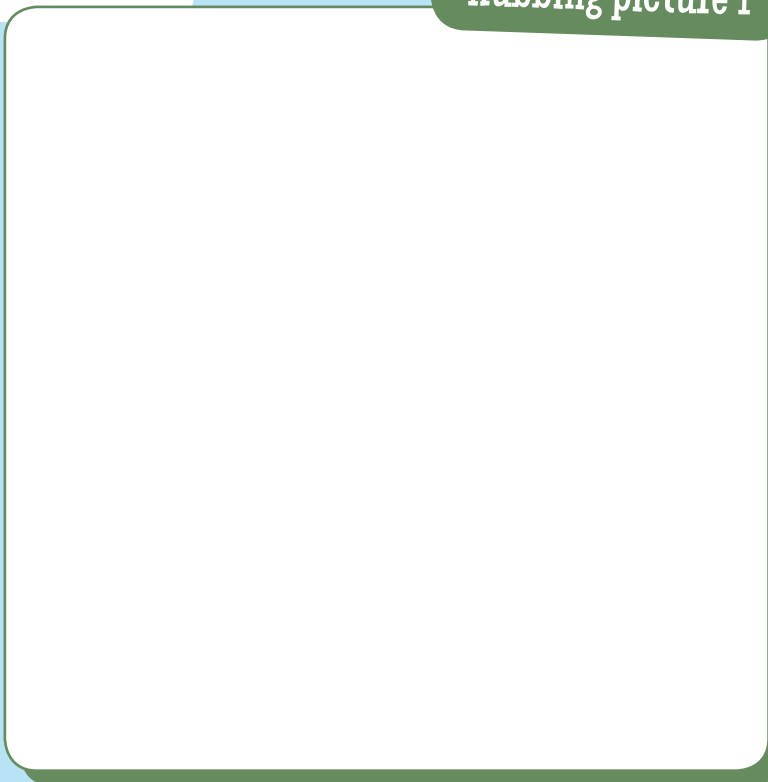


Rubbing Posts

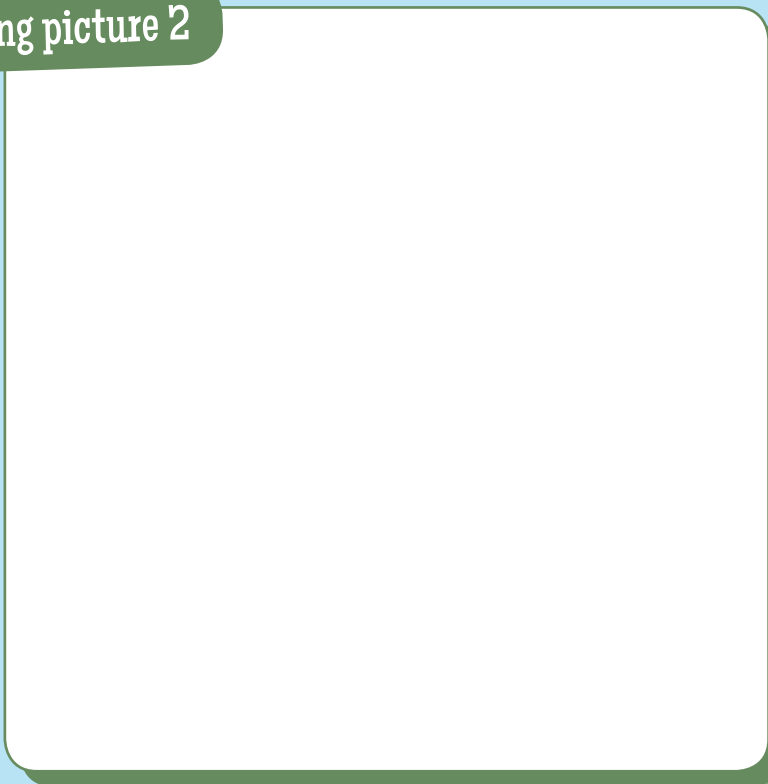
There are four wooden posts placed around the garden. On top of each post is a picture of an animal.

Place your paper over the picture and rub your pencil over the top, the picture should appear! Did it work?

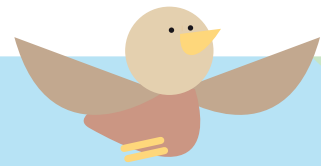
